**NOTE: there are no Men's Singles and/or Women's Singles events in this tournament.*

all mixed doubles pairs will start in a regular Round Robin/KO draw – this event will serve as the first event towards a Canadian Mixed Doubles Ranking; it is important for players aiming to qualify for Olympic qualification through the ITTF Olympic qualifying process that these mixed doubles pairs are made up of **both players being Olympic eligible.

****this event serves as the qualifier for the North American Hopes Challenge which – in a new format – will be hosted May 28th - June 2nd, 2019 in the USA. Players born in 2007 and 2008 can qualify for the 2019 North American Hopes Challenge – a wild card spot for the best player born after 2008 may be available – this spot will be decided by coach selection.*

NOTE: THE CANADA CUP WILL BE A SIGNIFICANT PART OF THE NATIONAL TEAM SELECTION PROCESS. NATIONAL TEAM COACHES WILL BE PRESENT AT CANADA CUP EVENTS AND EVALUATE PLAYERS FOR 'COACH SELECTION' SPOTS ON THE NATIONAL TEAM.

WITH THE INCLUSION OF MIXED DOUBLES IN THE OLYMPIC PROGRAM TTCAN WILL ESTABLISH A MIXED DOUBLES RANKING AFTER THIS CANADA CUP EVENT.

4 - ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

- Canada Cup #3 is an open competition - members in good standing of ITTF member associations may participate.
- Only players who born in 2006 or before may participate in Mixed Double events.
- Players may enter two events per day.
- Hopes players can enter only the Hopes event on Saturday and the Cadet event on Sunday.

5 - MAXIMUM ENTRY

- A maximum of 64 competitors per event (cut off by rating).
- A maximum of 32 Mixed Doubles pairs will be accepted for Mixed Doubles events (cut off by combined rating).

6 - COMPETITION FORMAT

- Competition formats will be based on the number of entries.

7 - ENTRIES

Players and Coaches:

Online registration will be available on the TTCAN website as of November 19th, 2018.

**Team members must register for individual events (including Mixed Doubles) through online registration.*

8 - ENTRY DEADLINE

Individual events: January 5, 2019

Coach registration: January 5, 2019

Cancellation and entry fee deadline: January 5, 2019

**Administration fee will apply for cancellations after the deadline. Late entries will not be accepted.*

9 - ENTRY FEES

**Team Registration fee covers entry fee for all individual events including Mixed Doubles.*

- Mixed Doubles \$75/pair
- Cadet 15 Boys Singles (Born in 2004 or later) \$30
- Cadet 15 Girls Singles (Born in 2004 or later) \$30
- Hopes Boys Singles (Born in 2007 or later) \$30
- Hopes Girls Singles (Born in 2007 or later) \$30
- Rating Events (800-1800, 1801-2800) \$30
- Veterans \$30

Coach Registration:

- *Coaches must be NCCP Competition Introduction 'Base Certified' for 2018 – same requirement as for the Canadian Championships Competition Development certification, former Level 3 and Level 4 (in progress or fully certified) are considered higher and therefore accepted.*
- *Coaches planning to coach at the Canada Cup must register; a \$25 registration fee applies.*
- ***Coaches who participated in Canada Cup #1 and/or #2 do not need to register for #3.***
- *Coaches must present photo coach IDs to Officials before the matches start.*
