TEAM ENTRY:

Each Member Provincial/Territorial Table Tennis Association in good standing with Table Tennis Canada may enter a team in the Canadian Championships.

The selection of the teams is the responsibility of the Provincial/Territorial Association. A maximum of 10 teams may be entered in each team event.

- A P/T member association nominates a Team of 3 or 4 players per team event.

If fewer than 10 teams are entered in an event, then the balance is filled according to the following:

- **PRIORITY #1 Combined Teams:** P/T member associations that cannot field their own team of 3 players, may nominate a combined team (ex. Team Atlantics). In this case, the P/T member associations that are involved are responsible of communicating amongst each other to create the combined team. All athletes must meet the athlete eligibility.
- **PRIORITY #2 "B" Teams:** if there are fewer than 10 teams entered in an event, "B" teams will be considered. The host province will have priority of entering a "B" team. The "B" Teams entry must follow these guidelines:
 - P/T member associations that have entered a Provincial Team (non-combined) may enter a "B" Team (Priority 2). If more than one province chooses to enter a "B" Team, the highest rated "B" team will be entered. (E.g., If there are only 6 teams entered, the top 4 highest rated "B" teams will be entered with the first spot awarded to the host province).
 - Players on a "B" team must be rated lower than any player on that province's "A" team. Each province can only have 2 teams; one "A" Team and possibly one "B" Team per event.
 - Players on a "B" team cannot accumulate points for the Jacques Bobêt Cup

Players nominated by their provincial /territorial association through the Team Entry will be automatically entered into the singles events for which they are eligible.

Players eligible for more than one age event will be entered into two single events: a) one that they belong according to their date of birth and if possible b) the next age eligible event.

The provincial / territorial association is responsible for entering the players in the appropriate age events.

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY:

To represent a P/T member association, a competitor must be:

- A member in good standing of a member association and with Table Tennis Canada
- A Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident. All players shall have proof of citizenship or permanent resident.
- If a player has resided in one or more provinces/territories, the player must represent the province/territory for which he/she is listed on the rating list at entry deadline.

ENTRY PROCESS:

TEAMS

- Member associations will nominate their teams by June 1st, (confirm if they will enter a team.)
- TTCAN will issue a call for B teams on, June 3rd if spots for B-teams are available

ENTRY DEADLINE WITH TEAM COMPOSITION: JUNE 10th, 2019

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

- Member associations will enter players in the Individual Events:
ENTRY DEADLINE JUNE 10th, 2019
- The remainder of the available spots per event will be filled by individual players submitting their entry or by the provincial/territorial association entering players for the individual events.

FINAL ENTRY DEADLINE: JUNE 17th, 2019

All individual entries will need to be confirmed by provincial organizations not later than June 20th.

TEAM SUBSTITUTIONS (CHANGES TO TEAM COMPOSITION):

Substitutions requests must be emailed to the tournament referee and the competition director. No substitutions or additions to the team composition will be considered after the adjournment of the Jury Meeting.

DRAW FORMAT and SEEDING:

- **Singles events** will be made up of 2 stages
 - 1st stage Round Robin groups with groups of 4 or more
 - 2nd stage
 - If 48 or less entries per event
 - Progressive knock-out for each division (1st and 2nd from RR to advance to Division A, others in Division B)
 - If more than 48 entries per event
 - Main draw - Single elimination (1st and 2nd from RR)
 - Consolation – Single elimination (all others from RR)
- **Doubles events** will be single elimination.
- **Team events** will be Progressive Knock-Out
- The Team event playing format will be the Olympic Team

- **Order of play:**
 - Match 1: BC vs YZ (Doubles)
 - Match 2: A vs X
 - Match 3: C vs Z
 - Match 4: A vs Y
 - Match 5: B vs X

- ALL matches in all events (Singles and Teams) will be best of 5.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel an event due to insufficient entries (minimum 4 players/pairs).
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify a format of play at their discretion.
- The draws will be published on June 26th on the TTCAN website.
- The rating period used for the entry (June 2019) shall be used to determine the seeding order for all events.
- Separation by provincial association will be applied whenever possible in Round Robins and first round of knock out draws.
- Seeding of doubles shall be based upon the combined rating points of both players.
- Seeding of teams shall be based upon the combined total of the three highest players on the team.

Jacques Bobêt Cup: The P/T association accumulating the most points will be awarded the Jacques Bobêt Cup. The standing of the Bobet Cup will be published on July 9th.

A **Fair Play Award** will be awarded to a player who demonstrates the most “fair play” and sportsmanship characteristics.

Award Ceremonies will take place at the venue:

- July 4th for team events
- July 6th for single events
- July 7th for double events

All participants in their sports attire attending award ceremonies should report to control desk half an hour before scheduled ceremony



ENTRY FEES:

All entry fees are in Canadian Dollars and include rating and administrative fees.

Players may register for a maximum of two age categories: the age category they are eligible for and the one **immediately** above

Mini Cadet - \$180 (includes U13 and U15 singles events, and all related U13 double events)

Cadet - \$180 (includes U15 and Junior 18 singles, and all related U15 double events)

Junior - \$130 (includes singles and doubles events)

Team Events:

\$175 per team entry in the team events

Coach Registration Fee: 25\$ per coach

NOTE: Only registered coaches can actively coach at the tournament. If you have issues with your coaching certification please, contact TT Canada asap.

Coaches who participated in the Canadian Senior Championships do not need to register for the Junior Championships.

Coaches must present TTCAN issued coach IDs to Officials before the matches start

- June 3rd TTCAN announces "B" Team availability,
- June 10th Complete provincial entry (singles/doubles/teams – names & payment):
- June 17th Individual entries
- June 19th Entry confirmations (on the TTCAN website)
- June 26th Final Schedule and Draw
- July 3rd Jury Meeting

Individual entries may be submitted between June 1- 14, 2019.

Entries are complete with registration through Sport Lomo and the full entry fee payment is received. The online entry through Sport Lomo and payment system will be available as of May 15, 2019.
