### **Accommodation**

- All players from QC, BC and MB will receive 125\$ (supporting two days accommodation and sharing hotel double room)

### **Transportation**

- Players from BC           each player will receive 450\$ support towards airfares
- Players from QC           each player will receive \$165 support for transportation or if organized travel through FTTQ 165\$ x number of registered players
- Players from MB           each player will receive 330\$ airfare support

## 11 Format

- Invited players will play three consecutive tournaments
- First two tournaments will be knock-out
- Third tournament will be progressive knock-out
- Winner of the first and second tournaments will not participate in the following tournaments
- If there will be less than 5 registered players per event, a round robin will be organized
- All matches will be best of five

## 12 Seeding

Players for the first tournament will be seeded according to last available TTCAN ranking list (before the

a) tournament)

*Note: In future, players will be seeded according to the standing of the last selection tournament.*

*Protected seeding positions could be made by the High Performane Committee when necessary.*

b) Players for the second tournament will be seeded based on results from the first tournament

1st seeded will be finalist from the first tournament

2nd seeded will be better ranked semi-finalist from the first tournament

3rd seeded will be weaker ranked semi-finalist from the first tournament

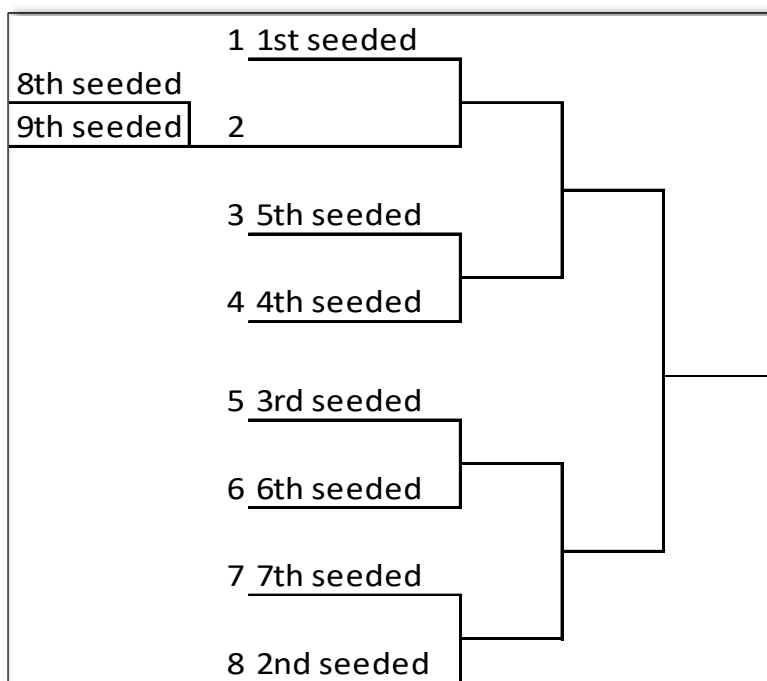
4th seeded will be best ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament

5th seeded will be second ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament

6th seeded will be third ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament

7th seeded will be the weakest ranked quart-finalist form the first tournament

c) Players for the third tournament will be seeded based on results from the second tournament similar seeding as b)
