We would like to encourage provincial associations to manage the players' accommodations and transportation. On the date the prospectus is issued airfares from Vancouver are 350\$, from Edmonton \$290. Renting a car for three days is \$76. Hotels for three days are between \$270-\$360. Support is based on those figures and assumption that players from QC and ON will travel by car.

12 Format

Junior's Boys and Girls Singles (scroll to bottom to see graphic presentation)

Phase 1

- All junior players listed at junior NT list (invited players in italic font) will be divided in groups of 3 or 4 and play round-robin tournament. This tournament will be qualifications for Men's and Women's Singles tournament

Phase 2

- Top two players from each Junior group will earn the right to play Men's and Women's Singles tournament
- All junior players listed at Senior NT list will be playing Men's and Women's Singles tournament without qualifications
- Players advancing to final of any of two senior tournaments will be entered in NA Olympic Qualification
- Juniors advancing at each round of second senior tournament will earn spots at higher rounds of juniors Phase 3

Phase 3

- Third and fourth player from each round robin group of Phase 1 will play round robin Junior ranking tournament (Phase 3b)
- Juniors losing R16 of second senior tournament will play qualification match for reaching next round; losers will play additional matches in progressive KO format
- Winners of a) and QF losers of second senior tournament will play qualification match for reaching next round; losers will play additional matches in progressive KO format
- Winners of b) and SF losers of second senior tournament will play qualification match for reaching next round; losers will play additional matches in progressive KO format

Final Standings

Final Standings will be established in following order:

- Players reaching finals of first senior tournament
- Players reaching finals of second tournament
- Players playing Phase 3
- Players playing Phase 3b

All junior matches will be best of five

In case that number of registered players is significantly different than invited

- **TTCAN may change the format of juniors tournaments**

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Men's and Women's Singles

Two single knock-out tournaments will be organized for each gender (seniors and juniors players)

- Winner of the first tournament will not participate at the second one

Mixed Doubles

Knock out (KO)

All senior matches will be best of seven

13 Seeding

Last available Canadian ranking list will be used.

Men's and Women's Singles

- a) Direct snake system
- b) Players for the second tournament will be seeded based on results from the first tournament
 - 1st seeded will be finalist from the first tournament
 - 2nd seeded will be better ranked semi-finalist from the first tournament
 - 3rd seeded will be weaker ranked semi-finalist from the first tournament

- 4th seeded will be best ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament
- 5th seeded will be second ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament
- 6th seeded will be third ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament
- 7th seeded will be fourth ranked quarter-finalist from the first tournament
- 8th seeded will be best ranked R16 player from the first tournament

Mixed Doubles

- Direct snake system. Combined rating points of both partners will be used to determine seeded pairs.

Juniors Boys' and Girls' Singles

- Direct seeding system will be applied.
- Losers of the higher round of the second tournament will be seeded first (higher seeded position)
- Same principle will be applied as for senior tournament

14 Schedule

Detailed schedule will be published once the number of registered players is known

15 Selection procedure

Men's and Women's Singles

- Winners of the first and second tournament (Men's and Women's Singles) will represent Canada at North American Singles Olympic Qualifications

Mixed double

- Winner of the mixed double tournament will represent Canada at North American Mixed Doubles Olympic Qualifications

Junior's Boys and Girls Singles

- a) Three junior boys and junior girls will be selected based on Final Standings
 - b) Fourth players will be decided by the nominated coaches for the 2020 PanAm Junior Championships
- Notes (exceptions):
- If four junior players reach finals of the senior tournaments all four will be selected for the junior team
 - If junior player is absent from this selection tournament he/she will be eligible for the 4th spot only if has at least one national team higher level than any of the players that has participated at this selection tournament

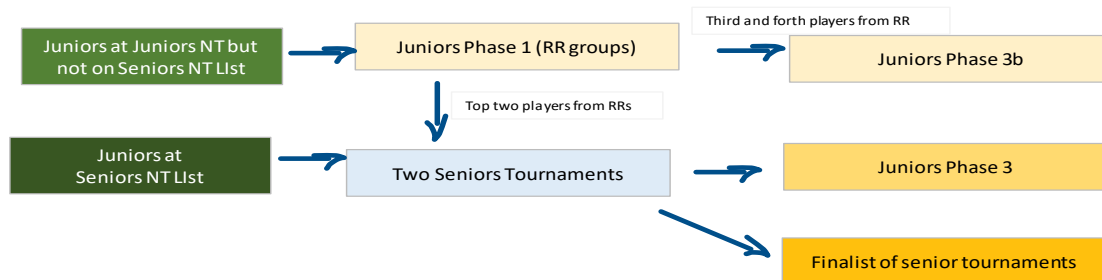
16 North American Singles and Mixed Doubles Olympic Qualifications

North American Singles and Mixed Doubles Olympic Qualifications will be organized on March 7 and 8 at the same venue.
 On March 7 singles with maximum two players from Canada and Bermuda.
 On March 8 mixed doubles with maximum one mixed double pair from Canada, Bermuda and USA

17 Pan American Junior Championships

2020 PanAmerican Junior Championships will be organized in Rosario, Argentina from 22 to 27 of June. It is also team qualification event for 2020 World Junior Championships
