Players that are not officially classified by the Para ITTF department may receive a temporary classification, which will be issued by Ian Kent, Para Table Tennis Program Manager, at My Table Tennis Club Mississauga on Friday September 25, 2020 between 2:00PM-4:00PM.

5 – ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

All players must be members in good standing of their respective Provincial/Territorial Table Tennis and with Table Tennis Canada. You are NOT a member in good standing with Table Tennis Canada if you owe money. All debts must be paid by August 31, 2020 .
