\*\*To be selected to international events, including Major Games and the 2023 Pan American Games, players must have **participated** in the **most recent National Championships** held prior to the selection.

\*\*\*The results of these Championships count for the Canadian rating system. Players must have an **active Canadian rating** to be **considered** for **National Team Activities**. New players will obtain a Rating after the Championships' results are processed.

#### 4 – CLASSIFICATION

**Players** that are **not officially classified** by the Para ITTF department may receive a temporary classification, which will be issued by John MacPherson, member of the ParaTT Advisory Group, at My Table Tennis Club Mississauga on Friday October 28 starting at 5:00 PM.

#### 5 – ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

All players must be members in good standing of their respective Provincial/Territorial Table Tennis Association.

Players must be in good standing with TTCAN. Players are considered not in good standing if they have unpaid invoices to TTCAN. **All debts must be paid by September 30, 2022.** Payments can be made by e-mail transfer to: melanie@ttcanada.ca

All participants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents. Proof is required for new players.

#### 6 – COMPETITION FORMAT

##### **Singles:**

- Stage 1: full round robin where possible
- Stage 2: knock-out If more than 8 entries in any one class

**Team:** Round Robin

**All matches** will be best 3 of 5.

The Referee and the TTCAN Technical Director have the right to modify any format based on the number of entries.

#### 7 – SEEDING LIST

Players will be seeded according to the last available Canadian Ranking. Players who do not have a Canadian Ranking will be ranked at the discretion of the Referee and the representative of the TTCAN ParaTT Advisory Group.
